

# Swim Center- Guidelines

## Circle C Ranch Swim Center



Welcome to the Circle C Swim Center. The Center features an Olympic size pool (4' 7" - 5' 2" in depth); with a recreational swimming area (3' 3" - 5' in depth). The pool is set up for short course lap swimming. The facility boasts a terraced landscape with pool side lounging, a basketball court, cafe and a new toddler pool with interactive water features (targeting a summer 07' opening). If you are a Circle C Resident in good standing, come enjoy one of our great aquatic programs or just swim, have fun and relax by one of the largest heated private community pools in south Austin. Circle C residents are permitted two guests per resident per visit. Residents will be admitted with their ID cards. Guests must pay a fee of \$3 and sign a liability waiver. Children under 3 are free.

## Swimming Pool

These guidelines have been established for the health, safety and fun for all.

### General Information:

- Water Wings, flotation suits or inflatable devices are not recommended. Coast guard approved life jackets are complimentary and available for checkout.
- Children 6 years and under or non-swimmers must be accompanied by an adult that can swim. The adult must wear a swimsuit, and be within arms reach of the non-swimmer at all times.
- Children 9 and younger must be accompanied by an adult that can swim.
- Photo taking devices are not permitted in the bathrooms.
- For the safety of your belongings, please leave valuables at home. The CCHOA/Swim Center is not responsible for lost or stolen items.

### Health Rules:

- **Children under 3 must wear a swim diaper; no exceptions!** Swim diapers can be purchased at the Swim Center front desk.
- A cleansing shower is recommended before entering and after exiting the pools.
- Swimmers must wear a swimsuit. No shorts, cutoffs or tee-shirts allowed in the pool.
- Gum or tobacco products are not permitted in the pool area. Snack items and baby food permitted upon management approval.
- Persons intoxicated from alcohol or drugs WILL NOT be allowed to use the facility.
- Persons with a communicable disease transmissible via water, wearing bandages, having open cuts or wounds WILL NOT be allowed to use the facility.
- The Pool or baby pool will be closed for a minimum of 8 hours when water contamination occurs in that specific body of water.

### Safety Rules:

- The lifeguard has the ultimate authority. Patrons must follow all instructions and direction given from the lifeguard.
- No running on the deck.
- Rough play, pushing and fighting, offensive language or behavior are not allowed in the facility.
- NO DIVING. Feet first entries only.
- Back dives/jumps, throwing bodies and shoulder mounts are not permitted.
- Masks (w/ tempered glass or plastic view), snorkels and fins are only allowed during Lap Swim, special supervised programs or permission from management.
- Personal swimming devices and pool toys permitted upon management approval. Hard balls and boogie boards not permitted.
- The pool will be cleared of all patrons for 30 minutes after each occurrence of lightning or thunder.
- Animals are not permitted within the fenced pool area.
- All guests of Circle C Residents must pay a \$3 fee or gain entry with a bulk guest pass and sign a liability waiver.
- Bicycles, skate boards, scooters and rollerblades are not permitted within the pool complex.

### Toddler Pool Rules:

- The toddler pool area has been designed for use by children 6 and under.
- Children must be supervised by adults at all times. Non-swimmers must be within arms length.
- Slide feet first on your back only.
- Toddler pool participants must follow direction of the lifeguard at all times.
